

# Clark International Airport Reviews

Clark International Airport (Filipino: Paliparang Pandaigdig ng Clark; Kapampangan: Pangyatang Sulapawan ning Clark; formerly named as Diosdado Macapagal International Airport) (IATA: CRK, ICAO: RPLC) is a major aviation center in the Philippines located within the Clark Freeport Zone serving the general area of Angeles City in the Philippines; and it is about 43.2 NM (80.0 km; 49.7 mi) northwest of Manila.

The Clark International Airport is surrounded by the cities of Angeles and Mabalacat; and conveniently reached by Subic-Clark-Tarlac Expressway which is linked into North Luzon Expressway. Clark serves the general vicinity of Greater Manila Area, along with the northern regions of Luzon. It is currently a hub for Cebu Pacific and Tigerair Philippines. The airport mainly serves low-cost carriers. The name is derived from the former American Clark Air Force Base which was the largest overseas base of the United States Air Force until it was closed in 1991 and handed over to the Government of the Philippines.

Clark International Airport is managed and operated by Clark International Airport Corporation (CIAC), a government-owned enterprise; and the southern part of the facility is utilized by the Philippine Air Force as Clark Air Base.
